Thank you for your interest in our ***In Vitro Fertilization (IVF)*** program at Fertility Consultants. Enclosed you will find preliminary information and reading materials relating to an IVF cycle.

To find out if you are a suitable candidate for the IVF program, please contact us at (503) 418-3700, Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m., to schedule a consultation visit with one of our IVF specialists: Kenneth Burry, M.D. • Phillip Patton, M.D. • Marsha Gorrill, M.D. • David Lee, M.D. If you are a new patient, your IVF consult will be \$300 and is due at the time of your appointment. If you are an established patient with one of our physicians, the fee will range from \$105 to \$225 depending on the complexity of the appointment. Our clinic is located in the RiverPlace area of downtown Portland. In addition, IVF candidates will attend an orientation class in our clinic to obtain extensive, in-depth information and protocols for an IVF cycle.

If you have made an appointment with one of our physicians, here are a few things that you can do before your consultation visit:

- If available, obtain a copy of your previous medical records outlining pertinent information relating to your current condition. If your partner has had an evaluation, these records are helpful also. Any blood work, surgeries, previous evaluations and previous methods used to attempt conception should be brought to your consultation visit.
- If you have insurance coverage, verify your infertility benefits with your insurance carrier and obtain a preauthorization and/or explanation of benefits.
- If you know that you will be using donor sperm for your IVF cycles, phone (503) 418-3700 for a complete list of donors and the selection process worksheets.
